Nev holds both helicopter and fixed wing licences with endorsements on a range of aircraft, and has set a course for Fortescue's growth.

So join the rush to hear him outline that course at the Sheraton on the Park on 30 August. The room will be full of miners, investors, bankers, brokers, and reporters.
