(JDS) to provide engineering services and undertake economic scoping work on the Company's Coffee Gold Project, Yukon Territory.

Ms. Allison Rippin Armstrong has over 14 years of experience in permitting, regulatory processes and environmental compliance working with First Nations, resource companies, Institutions of Public Government (IPGs) and the Federal Government of Canada. She has worked in jurisdictions such as NWT, Nunavut, Saskatchewan, Alberta and Ontario successfully permitting projects from grassroots exploration through to the final steps of water licensing for mines. Her recent experience includes working with [Prodigy Gold Inc.](#) (a wholly owned subsidiary of [Argonaut Gold Inc.](#)) to initiate the permitting process for the re-opening of the Magino Gold Mine in Ontario and acting as a key member of the team that successfully re-permitted the Jericho Diamond Mine and achieved the issuance of an 8-year water license.
