

Arbitration Court Upholds Jurisdiction for Stans Energy Claim

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Toronto, Ontario CANADA, March 31, 2014 /FSC/ - [Stans Energy Corp.](#) (HRE - TSX Venture), ("Stans" or the "Company") has been informed that the Arbitration Court at the Moscow Chamber of Commerce and Industry (the "Court"), has upheld its jurisdiction on the matter between [Stans Energy Corp.](#) and the Government of Kyrgyzstan.

The Government of Kyrgyzstan had put forth a claim that the Court had no jurisdiction in deciding the case brought against it by the Company. The Court ruled that it did in fact have jurisdiction over the matter and set the final hearings in the case over two days; April 29-30, 2014.

BACKGROUND

On October 30, 2013, [Stans Energy Corp.](#) and its subsidiaries filed a claim for arbitration under the Convention for the Protection of Investor's Rights to which Kyrgyzstan is a signatory. The arbitration hearings are being heard in the Arbitration Court at the Moscow Chamber of Commerce and Industry. The Company claims that certain actions by agencies and/or representatives acting on behalf of the Government of the Republic of Kyrgyzstan were aimed to impede the Company from executing its responsibilities under its licence and have created conditions for termination of the operations of Kutissay Mining LLC, the Company's wholly owned subsidiary, amounting to expropriation.

The claim seeks \$117,853,000 in compensation for losses and damage.

In December 2009, Stans acquired a 20-year mining license for the past-producing Kutissay II rare earth mine from the Kyrgyz Republic. On May 26, 2011 Stans completed the purchase of the Kashka Rare Earth Processing Plant (KRP) the same plant that previously refined REEs historically from Kutissay II. The KRP was the only hard rock plant to produce all rare earth elements outside of China, producing 120 different metals, alloys, and oxides. For over 30 years, Kutissay II produced 80% of the rare earth metals for the former Soviet Union.
