The Company recorded a total loss of \$2,935,016 or \$0.06 per share for the three month period ended June 30, 2015, compared with a total loss of \$462,390 or \$0.01 per share for the corresponding period ended June 30, 2014. The Company's cash balance as at June 30, 2015 was approximately \$13.7 million, compared to approximately \$16.2 million as at December 31, 2014.
