

Copper One Files Appeal With Court of Quebec Against Mern's Decision to Suspend Its Valid Riviere Dore Exploration Claims

[Copper One Inc.](#) (TSX VENTURE:CUO) ("Copper One" or the "Company") has filed an appeal with the Court of Québec against the decision of the Ministère de l'Énergie et des Ressources naturelles ("MERN"), issued on February 8, 2017, to suspend all of Copper One's mining claims related to its Rivière Doré Project. Copper One strongly disagrees with MERN's decision to suspend its claims and will continue to exercise its legal rights.
