Aurelius Minerals Announces Closing of \$1.5 Million Private Placement at \$0.085 per Share

Toronto, November 30, 2020 - <u>Aurelius Minerals Inc.</u> (TSXV: AUL) (the "Company" or "Aurelius") is pleased to announce that the company has closed a private placement of 17,646,000 flow-through shares for gross proceeds of \$1.5 million. The flow-through shares were priced at \$0.085 representing a 55% premium to last close and a 63% premium to the 5-day VWAP.

"We are very pleased to achieve a significant premium to the current market pricing, which is a strong endorsement of the strength of our team and assets," said Mark N.J. Ashcroft, P. Eng., President and CEO of Aurelius. "I am extremely pleased that in the face of a pandemic, we were able to assemble a Nova Scotia based exploration team, design and execute an exploration program consisting of 10,000 metres of underground and surface diamond drilling, and discover new gold zones at the Aureus East property from the first drill platform."

In connection with the private placement, Aurelius expects today to issue to Sprott Private Resource Lending (Collector), LP, ("SPRL"), 10,916,404 common shares at a price of \$0.085 per share, in connection with the exercise by SPRL of its participation right to maintain its percentage shareholding of Aurelius. The value of the participation right exercise will be credited towards the First Deferred Payment in connection with the acquisition of the Aureus Gold assets.

The securities issued on these private placements will be subject to a statutory four month hold period expiring on March 31, 2021.
