

RETRANSMISSION: Origen Stakes Additional Lithium Claims in Newfoundland

Vancouver, October 18, 2021 - [Origen Resources Inc.](#) (CSE: ORGN) (FSE: 4VXA) (the "Company" or "Origen") is pleased to announce that it has staked an additional claim block covering approximately 3,500 hectares within the Newfoundland Lithium Belt. This brings the Company's total holdings to over 37,000 hectares in this newly identified and highly prospective lithium corridor.

These new claims are located adjacent to [Sokoman Minerals Corp.](#) and [Benton Resources Inc.](#)'s Golden Hope Joint Venture. Recent announcements by the companies reported high grade lithium values in grab samples taken from pegmatite dykes on their project. Origen's newly staked claims contain the following key characteristics as identified in the Company's earlier acquisitions that are indicative of lithium rich pegmatites:

- Similar tectonic setting to Kings Mountain and lithium pegmatite occurrences in Ireland;
- Age of the associated granite intrusive;
- Areas known for pegmatite occurrences;
- Highly favorable geochemical pathfinders;

"We are extremely excited about this acquisition, in a now proven lithium region. The team has worked tirelessly compiling the data out of Newfoundland and we are thrilled to acquire such a prospective asset. The recent announcement of the discovery of lithium bearing pegmatites on an adjacent claim block validates the prospectively of our existing land package and motivated us to acquire more claims in the area. We are eagerly awaiting the receipt of our work permits as fieldwork is planned to begin shortly. With Ganfeng Lithium already owning a 4.3% stake in the Company, Origen is in a prime position to increase value for our shareholders," states Company President, Blake Morgan.

Exploration Plans

The Company intends to mobilize crews into the region within the next few weeks to commence mapping, prospecting and geochemical sampling over its new holdings. The immediate goal is to define our priority target areas in this new prospective lithium belt by applying exploration techniques developed over the last two decades on the Avalonia (Leinster) pegmatite belt in Ireland. In addition to bringing priority targets to drill readiness on the Company's existing properties, the Company's technical team will continue to employ their extensive experience and knowledge to identify new prospective targets within this burgeoning lithium district.

About the Newfoundland Lithium Belt

The Newfoundland Lithium Belt exhibits all of the characteristics of a major lithium rich corridor as observed in Ireland and the Carolinas. There are key indicative signs that point to specific target areas with high expectations for the discovery of lithium rich pegmatites. Numerous occurrences of pegmatites have been observed that exhibit highly-favorable lithium-cesium-tantalum ("LCT") geochemical signatures. Mapping of the geochemical pathfinders for lithium has revealed distinct vectors that have guided the Company to focus

in on the more prospective areas and acquire a commanding land position in this new belt.

These geochemical pathfinders, on a regional scale, reveal a distinct corridor that transects Newfoundland and corresponds to the tectonic suture zone hosting the world-class Carolina Tin-Spodumene Belt and the lithium pegmatite occurrences in Ireland that have received significant attention in recent years. In addition, the age of the associated parent granites observed in Newfoundland coincides with the 'sweet spot' occurrence of highly favorable lithium rich pegmatites.

John Harrop, P Geo., a Qualified Person as that term is defined in NI 43-101, has prepared, supervised the preparation, or approved the scientific and technical disclosure in the news release. Mr. Harrop is employed by Coast Mountain Geological Ltd. He is not independent of the Company as defined in NI 43-101.
