

Ellis Martin Report: Highland Copper: CEO Barry O'Shea on America's Copper Crisis and the Copperwood Opportunity

Malibu, CA, United States - In this interview, Ellis Martin speaks with Barry O'Shea, CEO of Highland Copper Company (CVE:HI) (OTCMKTS:HDRSF), about the company's fully permitted Copperwood Project in Michigan's historic Upper Peninsula and why it is attracting increasing attention from Washington, D.C.

With a copper resource of 1.9 billion pounds inferred and 1.8 billion pounds measured & indicated Copperwood is one of the most advanced near-term copper development projects in the United States. O'Shea discusses the growing national focus on domestic copper supply, the project's White House recognition, federal funding opportunities, Michigan's support for responsible mining, and Highland's path toward a construction decision.
